
 Our curriculum is structured around 6 open questions:




ASSESSMENT AND HOW IT WORKS FOR US!

- *Teachers carry out a baseline this is completed within the first six weeks it is based on all the areas of learning within the EYFS Curriculum.
- *This is done through initially observations of interactions and social development.
- *Then assessments will be carried out individually regarding specific skills such as number and phonic recognition.
- *Last year we chose to be part of the Pilot baseline assessment this gave us an opportunity to provide feedback for the new statuatory assessment 2020 to be introduced with the new curriculum.
- *We also carry out a Speech and Language assessment similar in IT format to the baseline this supports our assessment of the children's understanding of language.
- *All of these assessments provide us with the information we need to adapt the curriculum for individual needs and starting points as well as organise appropriate intervention measures.
- *In previous years carrying out these assessments has resulted in pupils making good progress and leaving Reception having closed the gap with their peers.
