On Friday 7th July, Year 5 will be visiting The Severn Valley Railway as part of their topic work. The visit is used to support aspects of the History curriculum, World War II – evacuation.

The children will travel by coach, leaving school at 8.50 am returning to school by the same method by approx. 5.00 p.m.

Children are able to come in 1940s style clothing (boys in shorts, shirt, girls in summer dress etc).

Can children bring in a box, similar to a tea bag size box **before the trip** so we can get it covered in brown paper ready to be used as a gas mask container!

Children will need to bring a packed lunch together with two drinks – no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please. If children are not wearing 1940's clothing then they should wear school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. If the weather forecast is for sunshine, then please provide a sunhat!

The cost of the visit will require a contribution of **£10.00** per child. This is for the coach fare and insurance. School is able to cover the cost of the entrance and session charges. No child will be omitted from the visit, however, it is necessary to have substantial contributions in order for the trip to go ahead.

Please complete the form and return it to school by 26th June

Year 5 teachers will be the teachers in charge on the day.
