The Cyclops - a one-eyed

human-eating giant but also a tender

keeper of goats and sheep.



LO: Create a mythical monster

Medusa - a monstrous gorgon with living venomous snakes in place of her hair.



The Minotaur - had the head and tail of a bull and the body of a man.

- actions

Success Criteria

You will need to use these in your labels and annotations:

- Adjectives to build noun phrases (large, protruding horns)
- Adverbs with well chosen verbs (awkwardly lumbered)
- Similes a ear piercing, snarling laugh, louder than squawking seagulls

Horns are protruding menacingly from behind, pointed, twitching ears.

Veins bulging from strong arms. APPEARANCE

Never shows mercy, hunting his quarry until they can run no more. TRAIT

> Powerful legs, driving forward like a storm. APPEARANCE



Stalks in his dark maze, toying with his frightened prey TRAIT Gains satisfaction from toying with those sent as his sport. TRAIT

> Striking eyes dart from side to side, like dangerous lighthouses in the darkness. APPEARANCE

Licks his teeth, whilst scratching his claws on nearby walls, sending terror through the hearts of anyone near. ACTION
