We are delighted to share with you that on Friday 27th March we will be hosting our...

Wheeler's Lane Primary School Vision Day!

The day is an opportunity for all the staff in the school to share and celebrate their own passions. All the staff in school have chosen an activity that they are passionate about to share a learning experience with the children in (and out of) school.

Overleaf, you will find a list and description of all the activities available to your child. All the children can choose what they would like to do, however this is a logistical challenge! So, we need your help.

We would like you to help the children rank the activities, starting with **1 as their most favoured activity**, **2** for their 2nd choice, and so on up to **10** for their 10th choice.

Once we have received all the forms back, we will distribute the children across the activities, matching as many **1s** as possible, then as many **2s** etc. until we have assigned children to all the activities. We have a limited number of spaces for each activity – not all children will receive their first choice but we will match them to as low a numbered choice as possible.

There is a cost of £2-£5 for a few of the activities as they either include coach travel to the activity, the activity itself, or purchasing of specific ingredients. These are indicated clearly on the form overleaf. Please do not send money in with this form – requests for money will be made once the activity is assigned.

Every child will need a packed lunch, no hot school dinners will be available. We can provide a packed lunch for children who are in KS1, Reception, or in receipt of free school meals in KS2. For these children a form will be going onto ParentMail for you to advise us whether you would like to provide the packed lunch, or you would like us to. This will save an enormous amount of wasted food and time.
