

Extra-Curricular Clubs - Autumn Term 2021 (OOHL – Out Of Hours Learning)

It is important that we give opportunities to all pupils to learn new skills, enhance their talents, and increase their independence. WHEN ARE CLUBS RUNNING

Autumn half term 1 extra-curricular clubs run by staff will run from Monday 27th September 2021 to Friday 22nd October. Clubs run by external providers may be different, please check the information provided on the letters sent out.

HOW TO APPLY- RUN BY SCHOOL STAFF

To apply for a club space run by a member of school staff please check your ParentMail and submit the forms for the clubs that your child is interested in. Please do check with your child first whether or not they would like to go to the club. Children will then be selected at random to attend if there is capacity in that club. A message will be sent out via ParentMail if your child has been given a space on their choice of club. Our clubs are normally oversubscribed so places in clubs are not guaranteed, please bear this in mind when applying.

HOW TO BOOK-CLUBS RUN BY EXTERNAL PROVIDERS

External club letters give details of how to book and pay for your child's place with the Club Provider.

ATTENDANCE

Once you have secured a place on a club run by a member of school staff, please make sure that your child attends regularly. If sessions are missed, or if your child changes their mind about attending the club, please inform the office so we can offer the club place to one of the children on the waiting list.

POPULARITY

We offer a wide variety of clubs to ensure that our children are able to develop their talents and try out new activities. As the clubs tend to be very oversubscribed, each child will not be given more than 1 club at a time. We want to ensure a fair process and would like as many children to experience the activities as possible.

PICKING UP FROM AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Please see the Club Schedule for full details of locations and collection points. Collection points vary between the small hall door exit and the main entrance exit. Please wait near to the picking up points and maintain distance from other parents and carers. The Club leader will release the children out to you.

The collection policy is the same as for school, i.e., an adult should collect the children. Year 6 children may walk home, with your consent, only in the Autumn 1, and Summer terms when it is light at 4.30pm. In Autumn 2 and Spring terms we would expect them to be collected as otherwise it would mean them walking home in the dark.

Certain days will have more than one club coming out at the same time, please be patient while the club leaders dismiss the children.

PUNCTUALITY

Please be on time to collect your child. If a parent or carer is late collecting their child more than twice, the place will be withdrawn and given to another child.

CHILDREN IN EARLY YEARS (Reception and nursery)

We do not run clubs for Early Years children until the summer term. This ensures that our new children have time to settle into school.
